DAY 1 - Arrival > Tokyo (D)

Upon arrival at Haneda or Narita Airport, meet and greet by local representative. Transfer to Odaiba, an artificial island just off Tokyo Bay, famous for its shopping, entertainment and dining areas. Back to hotel and check-in.

DAY 2 - Tokyo (B/L/D)

Transfer to Mount Fuji area. Reach up to Station 5 (if weather permits). Lunch at Kawaguchi lake. Next destination, choose either one:

- i) Gotenba Outlet for shopping or
- ii) Oshino Hakkai- An area is filled with many tourist spots such as Japanese folk house with straw-thatched roof, the old temples, Museum of History and Folklore which building can be traced back to 1800s, as well as many gift shops and restaurants.

DAY 3 - Tokyo (B/L/D)

After breakfast, transfers for Tokyo City Tour: Asakusa Temple, Nakamise Street, Tokyo River Cruise on Sumida River (Asakusa – Hinodesanbashi).

Next, choose any two shopping destinations of the following:

- i) Shibuya
- ii) Shinjuku
- iii) Ginza
- iv) Akihabara

DAY 4 - Tokyo > Airport (B/L)

After breakfast, check-out from hotel. Transfer to next destination of choice, choose one of the following:

- i) Tsukiji Fish Market - Best known as one of the world's largest fish markets
- ii) Shinjuku Gyoen – One of Tokyo's largest and popular parks
- iii) Meiji Shrine – One of the popular shrines in Tokyo built in 1920 & dedicated to Emperor Meiji

Transfer to airport for flight departure. End of service.
