DAY 1 (1/9/2018) : ARRIVAL > BISHKEK

Upon arrival at Bishkek Airport, meet and greet by local representative. Transfer to Bishkek for city tour : Ala-Too Main Square, Open air Art Gallery, Panfilov Park, Oak Park, Erkindik Boulevard, State Museum of Fine Arts, Victory Square, walk along the Youth Alley, surrounded by two main buildings of the University (State National and International Universities), the National State Philharmonic, the statues of Manas and Manaschi, Osh Market. Overnight at Hotel Bugu 3*.

DAY 2 (2/9/2018) : BISHKEK > ISSYK KUL (B)

After breakfast at the hotel, depart to Issyk Kul, stopover at historical site: Remains of ancient city Balasagyn (10-12th century) consisting of a minaret, an open air museum of Balbals (carved stone figures) and a small archeological museum in Tokmok town. Continue to Cholpon Ata and visit an open air Museum of Petroglyphs (stone inscriptions) that contains more than 2000 petroglyphs dating from 800BC to 1200AD with drawings that depict hunting scenes, sacrifice, victory, war and everyday activities. Rukh-Ordo cultural complex and Regional Museum. World Nomad Games opening ceremony (Entrance fee excluded). Overnight at Karven Issyk Kul Hotel 3*.

DAY 3 (3/9/2018) : ISSYK KUL > CHOLPON ATA > ISSYK KUL (B)

After breakfast, proceed to visit Kyrchynjailoo (Semenov Gorge) where the Kyrgyz village is prepared for the festival. In the afternoon, enjoy World Nomad Games in Cholpon-Ata right on the shore of the Issyk-Kul Lake. Full day of World Nomad Games! Overnight at Karven Issyk Kul Hotel 3*.

DAY 4 (4/9/2018) : ISSYK KUL > KARAKOL (B/L/D)

After breakfast, depart to Karakol town, located at Far East part of the lake. Midway, visit a farm called Reina-Kench at Tepke village. Upon arrival at the farm, you will have a guided tour by the farmer (non-English speaking) who will show you his stable where he keeps racing horses, animal farm and gardening. You will have a translator to assist. Afterwards, you will be offered lunch prepared from organic products from the farm. Proceed with Karakol city tour: Visit local Sunday Bazaar, beautiful Russian Church made entirely of wood (built without nails), the Dungan Mosque (Dungan's are minority group of Chinese Muslims living in this region and originally from Western China), the Museum of Przewalski, a soviet renowned explorer of Central and East Asia. Dinner at a local Uighur family's house with Uighur food specialties. Overnight at Green Yard Guest House.

DAY 5 (5/9/2018) : KARAKOL > JYRGALAN (B/L/D)

After breakfast, depart to Jyrgalan Valley, a guided tour around the village, visit local's house and cooking class of Kyrgyz type of bread Boorsok – small pieces of dough fried in oil. Afterwards, taste freshly cooked Boorsoks with jam/honey over a tea. You will participate in cooking homemade food and have lunch together with the family who will tell stories of that region (locals don't speak English, their language is pure Kyrgyz not mixed with Russian). You will have a translator to assist in the communication. Overnight at Emil Guest House.

DAY 6 (6/9/2018) : JYRGALAN > CHON KEMIN (B/L/D)

After breakfast, we will take morning drive to Jeti-Ogyz, a lush valley with some striking red sandstone rock formations including the "Seven Bulls". It is also possible to visit a spa to take a bath which was built during Soviet time and still in operation. After that, visit Skazka (Fairy Tale) Canyon. We will have lunch picnic with lunch boxes in the open. The canyon was named due to its bizarre rocky landscape, which for many years has been transformed by wind into fabulous sculptures and formations. Some formations in have been named for their similarity to well-known objects. Dinner at a local family guesthouse. Enjoy a walking excursion around the village enjoying natural beauty of the countryside and the local people.

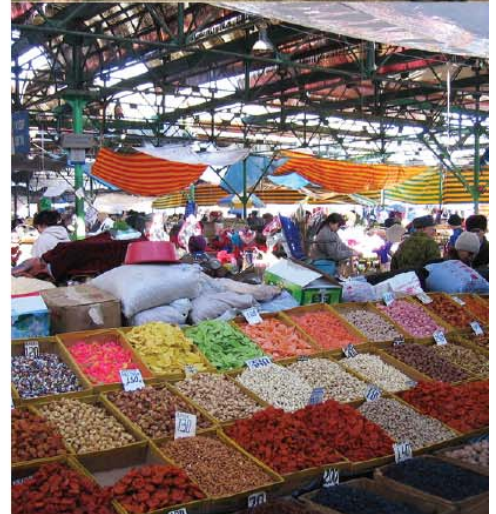
Folklore performance by villagers after the dinner. If more than 5 persons, there will be a campfire in the evening in the garden. Overnight at Ashuu Guest House.

DAY 7 (7/9/2018) : CHON KEMIN > BISHKEK (B/L/D)

After breakfast, take half-day horseback riding tour to Kalmak – Ashuu Gorge. Back to guest house to get some rest and lunch, before transfer back to Bishkek. Upon arrival, check-in hotel and free time until dinner transfer. Overnight at Bugu Hotel 3*.

DAY 8 (8/9/2018) : TBISHKEK > DEPARTURE (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. Free at own leisure till transfer to airport for your flight departure. (Standard Check-out time is at 12noon).
