IMPRESSIVE PHNOM PENH SIEM REAP

MINIMUM : 2 ADULTS

DAY 1 - PHNOM PENH (D)

Meet and greet at Phnom Penh International Airport. Visit the Royal Palace, built by King Norodom in 1866 and the Silver Pagoda. The Royal Palace of Cambodia is the royal abode of the King of Cambodia. Wat Phnom is the most significant of all the temples in Phnom Penh, founded by Daun Penh (Grandma Penh), a wealthy widow in 1372. The 27 meters high man-made hill became as Wat Phnom Daun Penh. Next, proceed to Tuol Sleng Genocide Museum (S21 Prison). This prison was a high school and used as a prison by Pol Pot's security forces and became the largest center for detention and torture during the rule of the Khmer Rouge. If time permits, shopping at Toul Tompong Market (Russian Market). Overnight in Phnom Penh.

DAY 2 - PHNOM PENH > SIEM REAP (B/L/D)

07:45am – Our driver will transfer to Mekong Bus station for departure to Siem Reap (6hrs traveling). You may choose to upgrade to one way domestic flight from Phnom Penh to Siem Reap. Upon arrival in Siem Reap, proceed for lunch before heading to hotel for check-in. After that, visit Chhng Khneas, a floating village on Tonle Sap Lake, the largest freshwater lake in Southeast Asia. The experience is wonderful as we pass by floating villages, friendly children in small boats and fishermen. Buffet dinner with cultural show at local restaurant. Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 3 - SIEM REAP : ANGKOR ARCHAEOLOGICAL PARK (B/L/D)

Start from Ta Prohm Temple, a beautiful temple bound by massive roots of huge trees then to Angkor Thom follow by Bayon Temple, a unique for its 54 towers decorated with over 200 smiling faces of Avolokitesvara. Proceed to Phimeanakas, Royal Enclosure, Elephants Terrace and the Terrace of the Leper King. Continue to explore Angkor Wat, the most famous of all the temples. Its distinctive five towers are emblazoned on the Cambodian flag and the 12th century masterpiece is considered by art historians to be the prime example of classical Khmer art and architecture. Last but not least, view a wonderful sunset from Angkor Wat or somewhere possible. Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 5 - SIEM REAP (B)

Check-out & transfer to Siem Reap Airport. End of service.
