DAY 01

BIG ALMATY LAKE TOUR & FALCON SHOW (6 hrs)

Meal L/- Meet with local guide in hotel lobby and start touring from *Al Farabi Avenue* with a visit to *Muslim mosque* and *University Nur-Mubarak* founded by the presidents of Kazakhstan and Egypt. Then, visit to 1st President Park, opened in respect of the First President of Kazakhstan, Nursultan Nazarbayev. The park is famous with its variety flower beds & fountains with picturesque mountains as the backdrop.

Continue driving to the *Big Almaty Gorge*. Visit drinking water supply construction, built by the imprisoned Japanese soldiers after the World War 2.

After lunch, proceed to the *Big Almaty Lake*, a natural alpine reservoir at an altitude of 2511m above sea level. Enjoy by relaxing and soaking in the natural views, admiring glaciers and snow peaks.

En route back to the town, visit the Falcon Farm, where you will enjoy a spectacular *Falcon Show* with specially trained hawks - hunting with them is one of the most unique features of the Kazakh way of life. *(Closed during winter time)*

Transfer back to the hotel. End of service.
