ITINERARY

DAY 01 ARRIVAL IN PHNOM PENH

Meet and greet at the airport by our friendly tour guide. Transfer to hotel. Overnight in Phnom Penh.

DAY 02 PHNOM PENH

The tour begins with visit to the **Independence Monument**, built in 1958 to memorialize Cambodia's independence from France in 1953. Then, visit the **Royal Palace**, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the Silver Pagoda, located within the grounds of the Royal Palace. The Royal Palace of Cambodia is a complex of buildings although it is generally understood to be the royal abode of the King of Cambodia. After lunch, visit to **Toul Sleng Genocide Museum (S-21)**, this prison was a high school, and used as a prison by Pol Pot's security forces and became the largest center for detention and torture during the rule of the Khmer Rouge. Next, visit the **Central Market (Psar Thmei)**, a large market constructed in 1937 in the shape of a dome with four arms branching out into vast hallways with countless stalls of goods. Evening, enjoy walking along the river bank for breaching fresh air and embark on **sharing boat ride** to view sunset along the **Chaktomuk River**. Overnight in Phnom Penh.

DAY 03 PHNOM PENH > SIAM REAP

Early morning, board shuttle minivan to **Siem Reap** (6 hrs traveling). En route, stop by Kampong Thom for rest & lunch (****lunch at own expenses**). Upon arrival Siem Reap, transfer for hotel check in. Noon, proceed to **Chhong Khneas**, the floating village located 10 kilometers south of Siem Reap. Visit the village and take an excursion in a traditional wooden boat to **Tonle Sap**, Cambodia's biggest natural water lake and one of the largest in Asia. Evening, return to the city and enjoy a **buffet dinner with Cambodian Folk Show**. Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 04 ANGKOR WAT

Drive to the World Heritage Site, visit the **South Gate of Angkor Thom** which is famous for its series of colossal human faces carved in stone, the impressive **Bayon Temple**, the **Royal Enclosure**, **Phimeanakas**, **The Elephant Terrace**, **The Terrace Of The Leper King & Baphoun Temple**. Continue visit **Ta Prohm**, one of the area's most beautiful temples, it has been left relatively untouched since it was discovered and retains much of its mystery. Admire the architectural masterpiece of **Angkor Wat**, stroll around this massive monument, exploring the many galleries with columns, libraries, pavilions, courtyards and ponds full of water reflecting the towering temple. Lastly, view sunset from where possible. Overnight in Siem Reap.
