DAY 01 | ARRIVAL IN ST PETERSBURG

Meet and greet at the St Petersburg International airport upon arrival. Proceed for hotel check-in. Overnight in St Petersburg.

DAY 02 | ST PETERSBURG

The tour begins with *St. Petersburg City Sightseeing Tour* where you will listen to amazing stories and to take fine pictures of the main architectural and historical sites like *Nevsky Prospect, Kazan Cathedral, Winter Palace, Vasilievsky Island, St. Isaac Cathedral, Peter and Paul Fortress, Senate Square and Palace Square*. Visit to *Peter and Paul Fortress*, the birthplace of Saint Petersburg & the foundation of this beautiful city began. After lunch, proceed to *St. Isaac's Cathedral*, the largest church in Saint Petersburg. Take a walk along *Nevsky Prospect*, the main street of the city, which hosted many important historical events. Continue to visit *Kazan Cathedral*, built in 1811 and associated with Russia's victory over Napoleon in 1812. Overnight in St Petersburg.

DAY 03 | ST PETERSBURG

St. Petersburg is also aptly called "North Venice", therefore join a *boat cruise along Neva rivers* and canals and enjoy breathtakingly views from the water and bridges over the city architecture. DAY 04 | ST PETERSBURG

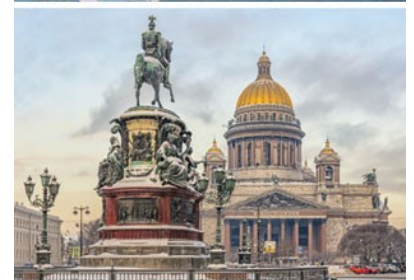

DAY 07 | MOSCOW

After breakfast, depart to **Sergiev Posad**, one of the real treasures of the Golden Ring route. Discover **The Trinity Lavra of St. Sergius**, a unique monastery complex and the spiritual center of Russian Orthodox Christianity. Noon, visit to **Goritsky Monastery of Dormiton**, a monastery museum complex which received its famous name from the location on the hill "Goritsa". Overnight in Yaroslavl.



DAY 09 | YAROSLAVL > SUZDAL

Continue with tour to Moscow baroque styled **Tolga Monastery** located on the bank of the Volga River. Then, visit the jewel of Yaroslavl city, **Church Of The Prophet Elijah**. After lunch, explore Suzdal, one of the most beautiful cities of the "Golden Ring" by visiting to **Kremlin & the Open Air Museum**. Admire the wooden construction built in the 10th century. Overnight in Suzdal.

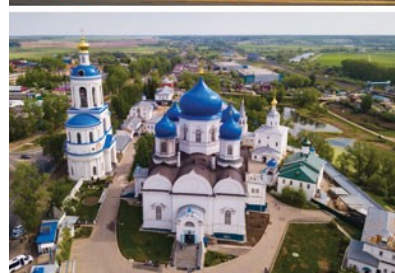
